

# Arts Award: qualification information

## (Published September 2020)

Arts Award is a national qualification which recognises how young people aged up to 25 years, can develop as artists and arts leaders. Arts Award is a personal learning programme which develops and assesses both arts-related and transferable skills, such as creativity, communication, planning and leadership.

Arts Award Explore, Bronze, Silver and Gold are on the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF), with Discover being a non-regulated introductory level certificated by Trinity College London. Arts Award qualifications\* are regulated by [Ofqual](#) (Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation) in England, [CCEA Regulation](#) in Northern Ireland and by [Qualifications Wales](#). The awarding organisation is Trinity College London. Trinity College London is the awarding organisation for Arts Award and manages the qualification in association with Arts Council England. Arts Award has also been mapped against the [European Qualifications Framework](#).

All Arts Award qualifications are assigned a total qualification time (TQT). Total qualification time is an estimate of the average time a young person spends with an adviser or adult to support them (guided learning hours) added to the average time spent learning independently. It is recognised that the amount of time needed to complete a qualification will depend on the level of experience of each individual or group. Trinity College London provides details of all successful candidates to the [Learning Records Service](#) (LRS) and to UCAS for young people completing their Gold Arts Award. In order to provide the details, check that you have registered young people's details correctly, including their Unique Learner Number (ULN) so that credits to UCAS points can be matched up correctly. A ULN is a **10-digit reference number** which is used alongside and to access the Personal Learning Record of anyone over the age of 14 involved in UK education or training.

## Further information

The level comparisons below are useful to get an idea of the standard of the Arts Award levels against qualifications delivered in secondary and further education settings. However, getting an Arts Award says something unique about a young person and the skills they've gained in creativity, communication, leadership and art form development.
